## Consultation on depot sites for the Cross River Tram

Thank you for your letter dated 19<sup>th</sup> December 2006 regarding the proposed Cross River Tram depot site in Peckham and the assessment of this site in relation to other candidate sites.

We do understand your concerns with the site in Peckham and are aware of the sensitivities associated with this location. We aim to work closely with Southwark Council to address the issues you identify as we develop the CRT scheme.

As you are aware, we have commissioned further work to review potential depot locations to ensure that any decision is based on the latest information. A number of potential sites will be considered against a range of criteria, and this will include sites in Southwark, Lambeth and Camden. CRT preferred depot locations will therefore be supported by objective technical work. The selection criteria, together with the outcome of the depot evaluation process, will be explained when we undertake our depot consultation later this year.

The key objective of the depot consultation will be to engage with the community on aspects of the preferred depot solution that are of most concern, with a view to working with stakeholders to address those issues.

I hope that the foregoing addresses your concerns and look forward to working with Southwark Council and the local community in delivering this exciting scheme.
