Data protection - privacy and transparency notice

Southwark Planning Network (SPN) is an informal network of local people taking action in planning matters affecting their own neighbourhoods. It is a citizens' action group run by volunteers. This is our statement of how we collect personal data and protect it.

How do we collect data?

We keep only information that you have given us, whether in person, or if you have contacted us by email.

What data do we keep?

If you have supplied them, we keep your name(s), addresses, phone number(s) and email addresses, web and social media links and your interest(s) in our work.

If you want to check the data we have about you, please email us and we will send it to you.

What do we use this data for?

We use this to keep you up-to-date with SPN work and to share information that is relevant to our work.

We occasionally also use address details to send information relevant to particular areas of the borough.

We maintain and operate the SPN mailing list.

Where is the data kept?

We keep this data in our information system database, which is password protected and limited to the SPN administrators. We do not share it with third parties.
