ONE WAY BUSES FOR RYE LANE?



Southwark Council is consulting on a one way option for Rye Lane. This means a walk of **600m** from Peckham Rye Station to the nearest bus stop at Nigel Road or Peckham Library.

Seamless connections between bus and rail? Under the one way option, NO LONGER

Peckham Rye Station is one of the busiest outside central London with 7m passengers a year. **But it could be the only major station without two way bus connections.**

Peckham Rye Station is due for a £40m makeover with lifts to all platforms. But without bus connections how do people with disabilities get safely home? Worse too -

- have heavy shopping or luggage
- with young children
- a woman having to walk late at night down Rye Lane
- or just a local resident wanting to get home quickly and safely
